Podgorica, 6-10 December 2019

The Universal Declaration is the first and most important international document for the protection of human rights, which defines standards relevant for each person and for groups, which should be observed in all states. Even if it was adopted as a political, and not as a legally binding document, the Universal Declaration has in time become a part of international customary law. Values contained in the Declaration are relevant and timeless 70 years after its adoption, and it is only by observing them and applying them fully in national systems that it is possible to build just and inclusive societies.

The programme organised to celebrate International Human Rights Day, aims at taking stock of the level of observance and protection of human rights and freedoms in Montenegro, focusing on areas recognised as challenging and demanding more intensive efforts by all involved parties to achieve the highest standard of implementation.
